INTRO

Decoding adds value to education, but its results are scattered and somewhat invisible. The web page *decodingthedisciplines.org* is helpful, but leaves the effort to add and curate content to a single person.

DECODING WIKI

- Makes sharing Decoding results a community endeavor with little individual effort.
- Allows to share results in a structured, yet flexible way.
- Can help to foster a community.

CONTENT TO SHARE

- Bottleneck descriptions
- Interview recordings and transcripts
- Teaching materials
- Publications
- Community affairs: announcements, calls, meeting minutes, ...

CURRENT PROTOTYPE

- Set up by German Decoding Working Group.
- Uses same technology as Wikipedia.
- Allows for restricted content (e.g. for recordings not to be intended for sharing publically).
- Is in a zombie-state, unfortunately.

WHAT TO DO

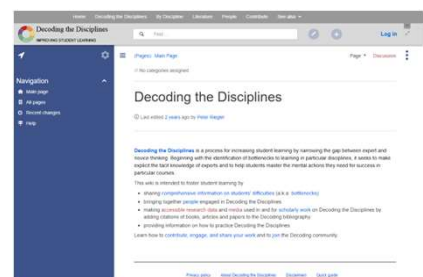
- Create user account
